Covid 19 Surgery admission policy

To ensure everyone's safety the Practice has implement the following policy

All patients will be asked enter the surgery unaccompanied unless they require a carer for communication or mobility, or they are a child.

Everyone entering the building will have their symptoms checked:

- any new cough
- any new cold/flu type symptoms
- new altered sense of smell or taste

Anyone with any of these new symptoms in the last 7 days will not be admitted to the surgery.

Everyone entering the surgery will also have their temperature checked.

Anyone with a raised temperature with or without any of the above symptoms, will be assessed over the phone and advised accordingly.

If there is an essential carer/parent who is found to have a temperature over 37.2, every attempt will be made to find an alternative adult to accompany the patient. If this is not possible it will be dealt with on a case by case basis after discussion with a partner or practice manager.
